

REGULATIONS FOR UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF LOS ANGELES COUNTY

This fact sheet provides essential information on the standards for garage sales, yard sales, or similar events in residential areas.

WHO can conduct yard sales?

 Only the property owners or residents of the dwelling unit where the sale is taking place can conduct yard sales.

WHEN can yard sales be conducted?

Last full weekend of each month

Designated Weekends

- Allowed 7:00 am 6:00 pm.
- No registration required.

Non-Designated Weekends

- Up to two additional weekends per year allowed.
- Allowed 7:00 am 6:00 pm.
- Registration is required.
 Registration is free.

Monday - Friday

Other

weekends

Never allowed.
 No exceptions!

WHAT can be sold at yard sales?

- You can only sell secondhand, household, or incidental personal items.
- Sale of new retail merchandise, food, and drinks is prohibited.

WHERE can yard sales be conducted?

- You may conduct sales at any residence within the unincorporated areas of LA County.
- You can only place items within the front and side yards of a residence.
- Signage and items are prohibited in the public sidewalk, parkway, street, and alley.
- You may place two on-site signs up to 4 sq. ft.
 each in area within the front and side yards.

When registering, individuals must provide proof of ownership or residence at the location of the yard sale. For example: a lease, ID with current address, utility bill, or other official mail matching the location.



Operators found in violation of these standards will be cited and may be subject to non-compliance fees and other penalties.
